Develop a community centre that is accessible by the whole community	119	<p>With no facilities willing or wanting to take young people without charging astronomical costs this is a must in the local area.</p> <p>Facility should be accessible by all age groups.</p> <p>Return Lochgelly Centre to the people – access for all.</p> <p>Lochgelly Centre – less culture, more contact.</p> <p>At the moment community centre is not 'young people friendly'</p> <p>Use empty buildings as a resource for social interaction for both young and older people.</p> <p>There are also excellent Community Use facilities at Lochgelly High School but agree this is restrictive as well.
